ACHIVEMENT Of RMC

Located at the foothills of Himalayas within Terai and Dooars region Dhupguri & belacoba had been for years an Agriculture produce Zone fulfilling the requirements of North Bengal, Bhutan and Northeastern regions. Considering its importance of the District Jalpaiguri Zilla Regulated Market Committee had been constituted under the provisions of the West Bengal Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation) Act, 1972 (VIDE NOTIFICATION NO. 1373-AM/P5A-17/2013, DT: 17-10-2014) of the Department of Agriculture marketing, Govt. of West Bengal after Dissolving the erstwhile Dhupguri & Belacoba RMC in the District of Jalpaiguri.

The prosperity of our nation primarily rests on the progress and prosperity of the agriculturists. To ensure the maximum financial return as the price of the produce of agriculturists better methods of marketing need to be adopted.

For this the Government took steps from time to time and the most important step taken is the passing of the West Bengal Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation) Act 1972 on the basis of which the Agriculturists can enter the Market with confidence with his produce to sale at his own terms and get the maximum return for it.

In West Bengal in the District of Jalpaiguri almost all types of facilities have been provided both to the seller and buyer and the interest of the producer seller is protected completely through Regulated Market Likely:

- a) To ensure correct weighing
- b) To settle disputes arising between buyer and seller.
- c) To provide up-to-date news service to the Market Users.
- d) To provide various amenities and facilities to the Market users etc.
- e) To rationalize Market practices.
- f) To develop the market infrastructures.
- g) To collect market fees from buyers/sellers.
- h) Licensing.
- i) Development of P.M. Yard.
- j) Development of Sub-Market Yard.
- k) Development of Market area under Jalpaiguri Zilla R.M.C
